AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 6, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 26.08 RELATING TO THE CITIZENS ADVISORY BOARD ON POLICE/COMMUNITY RELATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 6, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 26.08 to read as follows:

SEC. 26.08 CITIZENS ADVISORY BOARD ON POLICE/ COMMUNITY RELATIONS

- A. PURPOSE AND INTENT No change in this section &
- B. CITIZENS ADVISORY BOARD ON POLICE/ COMMUNITY RELATIONS ESTABLISHED
- 1. There is hereby created a Citizens Advisory Board on Police/Community Relations consisting of thirteen (13) members who shall serve without compensation. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The members shall serve until August 29, 1987. The Mayor may designate one (1) member as chairman.
 - No change in this subsection.
- C. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS No change in this section.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage and shall be automatically rescinded on August 29, 1987.
