ADOPTED ON JUN 30 1986

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-16649 (NEW SERIES), BY AMENDING SECTION 1. THEREOF RELATING TO ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR THE LEGISLATIVE BODY.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. O-16649 (New Series) on May 27, 1986; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance establishes a schedule of compensation for officers and employees of The City of San Diego for fiscal year 1986-87; and

WHEREAS, section 1. of said ordinance relates to the establishment of compensation for the legislative body; and

WHEREAS, recited therein is the acknowledgement that recommendations thereon had been submitted by the Salary Setting Commission by report dated February 14, 1986, for fiscal years 1986-87 and 1987-88, and the provision that the Council shall take appropriate action thereon in connection with its deliberations and anticipated action upon the annual appropriation ordinance; and

WHEREAS, budgetary hearings have progressed to that point which the Council deems adequate to identify the fiscal viability of the City and availability of funds for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, since the conditions of said Ordinance No. O-16649 (New Series) in this respect have been complied with, it is now appropriate to present for Council consideration and action those

recommendations submitted by the Salary Setting Commission, pursuant to its Charter sections 12.1 and 24.1 mandate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 16649 (New Series) dated May 27, 1986, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1986-87" be and it is hereby amended by amending Section 1. thereof to read as follows:

Section 1. LEGISLATIVE BODY, COMPENSATION ESTABLISHED.

Pursuant to Sections 12.1 and 24.1 of the Charter of The City of San Diego and the recommendations of the Salary Setting Commission as contained in its report to the Mayor and City Council, dated February 14, 1986, there is hereby established and adopted a schedule of compensation for the Mayor and Council members for the period July 1, 1986 through June 30, 1987, as follows:

Mayor \$55,000 per annum

Council Member \$40,000 per annum

The Auditor and Comptroller shall calculate and establish a table which shall be and is hereby adopted as the appropriate table of biweekly salaries most closely approximating the above authorized per annum compensation. The City


Attorney is hereby directed to include the second incremental increase, as recommended and adopted, in the fiscal year 1988 salary ordinance, unless otherwise directed by Council.

Section 2. The amendment to Section 1. set forth above shall and is hereby declared to be effective July 1, 1986.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
