AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 7, DIVISION 32, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 27.3209, RELATING TO TIME OF FILING NOMINATING PAPERS AND DECLARATION OF WRITE-IN CANDIDACY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 7, Division 32 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 27.3209, to read as follows:

SEC. 27.3209 TIME OF FILING NOMINATING PAPERS AND DECLARATION OF WRITE-IN CANDIDACY.

The nominating papers and declaration of write-in candidacy shall be delivered to the City Clerk no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the date of the election.

All nominating papers, including any petition in-lieu-of nominating fee, shall be filed at the same time; no supplemental filings are allowed.

Section 2. Pursuant to section 17 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, this ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
