AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 17 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO LIMITING THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS WHICH REQUIRE SEWER HOOKUPS IN THE SEWER PUMP STATION NO. 64 SERVICE AREA WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego, under the police power delegated to it by the Constitution of the State of California, has the authority to react when the potential exists for jeopardy to the public health, safety and general welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is alleged that since July, 1979, there have been 58 overflows from Sewer Pump Station No. 64 resulting in the discharge of millions of gallons of raw sewage into Penasquitos Lagoon; and

WHEREAS, it is alleged that Sewer Pump Station No. 64 is not operated and maintained in a manner that would provide reliable service and prevent sewage overflows; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Water Quality Control Board at its

June 16, 1986 meeting issued a Cease and Desist Order to The City

of San Diego to immediately stop sewage overflows into the

Penasquitos Lagoon; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Water Quality Control Board continues to monitor the operation of Sewer Pump Station No. 64 and the proposed improvements to said pump station; and

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego adopted Emergency Ordinance No. O-16686 (New Series) on July 14, 1986, to prohibit the issuance of any building permits and the approval of projects which required a sewer hookup in the Sewer Pump Station No. 64 service area through and including July 29, 1986; and

WHEREAS, it remains critically urgent and necessary to limit sewer hookups in the Sewer Pump Station No. 64 service area; and

WHEREAS, the situation herein described constitutes an emergency and the City Council finds that it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety to continue to limit the further issuance of building permits which require a sewer hookup in the Sewer Pump Station No. 64 service area within the City of San Diego should any of the events hereinafter listed occur; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, no building permits, except as otherwise provided herein, shall be issued which require a sewer hookup in the Sewer Pump Station No. 64 service area within the City of San Diego as delineated in that certain map filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-16686 if any of the events listed in (a) through (d) occur.

(a) Any failure to accomplish or complete the work as scheduled for improvements to Sewer Pump Station No. 64 as outlined in City Manager's Report No. 86-334.

- (b) Any sewage spill from Sewer Pump Station No. 64 that causes environmental damage to the Los Penasquitos Lagoon.
- (c) Any failure to conform to the requirements imposed on Sewer Pump Station No. 64 by the Regional Water Quality Control Board and said failure is confirmed by the Board.
- (d) Failure to comply with any cease and desist order issued by the Regional Water Quality Control Board regarding Pump Station 64 and such failure is confirmed by the Board.

Section 2. Upon the occurrence of any of the foregoing events, the City Manager shall be responsible for causing the immediate cessation of the issuance of building permits, except for those types of permits such as remodeling, interior or exterior building completion. Thereafter, at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council, the City Manager shall report the basis for his actions. The City Council shall, by resolution after conducting a hearing, approve or reject the City Manager's action.

Section 3. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure required for the immediate preservation of the public safety, health and welfare pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter

of The City of San Diego and shall take effect immediately and continue in force from the day of adoption thereof by two-thirds of the members of the City Council until Ordinance

No. 0-16695 (New Series) takes effect.
