ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 16723 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON OCT 06 1986

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING LOT 1, CHICARITA SUBSTATION, MAP 7574, LOCATED ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF AZUAGA STREET EAST OF RANCHO PENASQUITOS BOULEVARD, IN THE PENASQUITOS EAST COMMUNITY PLAN, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO A-1-1 AND CN ZONES, AS DEFINED BY SECTIONS 101.0404 AND 101.0426 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 8858 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED JULY 18, 1963, OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INSOFAR AS THE SAME CONFLICTS HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That in the event that within three years of the effective date of this ordinance, Lot 1, Chicarita Substation, Map 7574, Located on the south side of Azuaga Street east of Rancho Penasquitos Boulevard, in the Penasquitos East Community, in the City of San Diego, California, designated "A-1-1" and "CN" on Zone Map Drawing No. B-3639, is subdivided and a map or maps thereof duly submitted to the City and thereafter recorded, and within such subdivision or subdivisions provision is made for the installation of public utility services and the dedication of streets, alleys and easements for public use, the provisions of Sections 101.0404 and 101.0426 shall attach and become applicable to the said subdivided land, and the said subdivided land shall be incorporated into A-1-1 and CN Zones, as described and defined by Sections 101.0404 and 101.0426, the boundary of such zones to


be as indicated on Zone Map Drawing No. B-3639, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 769418. Said zoning shall attach only to those areas included in the map as provided in this section.

Section 2. That in the event the zoning restrictions shall attach to the said land described in Section 1 of this ordinance, Ordinance No. 8858 (New Series), adopted July 18, 1963, be, and it is hereby repealed insofar as it conflicts herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
