AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING A PORTION OF SECTION 7 OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER, RANGE 3 WEST, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, S.B.B.M., LOCATED WEST OF EL CAMINO REAL AND NORTH OF BLACK MOUNTAIN ROAD, IN NORTH CITY WEST COMMUNITY, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO MF-1 ZONE, AS DEFINED BY SECTION 103.0608 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 0-16074 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED OCTOBER 31, 1983, OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INSOFAR AS THE SAME CONFLICTS HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That in the event that within three years of the effective date of this ordinance a portion Section 7 of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, Range 3 West, Township 14 South, S.B.B.M., located west of El Camino Real and north of Black Mountain Road, in the North City West Community, in the City of San Diego, California, designated "MF-1" on Zone Map Drawing No. C-679.2, is subdivided and a map or maps thereof duly submitted to the City and thereafter recorded, and within such subdivision or subdivisions provision is made for the installation of public utility services and the dedication of streets, alleys and easements for public use, the provisions of Section 103.0608 shall attach and become applicable to the said subdivided land, and the said subdivided land shall be incorporated into MF-1 Zone, as described and defined by Section

103.0608, the boundary of such zone to be as indicated on Zone Map Drawing No. C-679.2, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. <u>769415</u>. Said zoning shall attach only to those areas included in the map as provided in this section.

Section 2. That in the event the zoning restrictions shall attach to the said land described in Section 1. of this ordinance, Ordinance No. O-16074 (New Series), adopted October 31, 1983, be, and it is hereby repealed insofar as it conflicts herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
