AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER IV, ARTICLE 4, DIVISION 3 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 44.0310 AND BY ADDING SECTION 44.0311 RELATING TO THE RESTRAINT OF ANIMALS IN OPEN VEHICLES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter IV, Article 4, Division 3 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending section 44.0310 and by adding section 44.0311 to read as follows:

SEC. 44.0310 ANIMALS IN TRANSIT AND DEAD ANIMALS

Except as provided in section 44.0311, nothing in this Division shall be applicable to dead animals or to animals which are in transit through the city for commercial abattoir purposes, provided there is no stoppage while in transit for longer than 24 hours.

SEC. 44.0311 ANIMALS IN VEHICLES

(a) No person shall transport or carry on any public highway or public roadway any animal in a motor vehicle, unless the animal is safely enclosed within the vehicle or protected by a cab or container, secured cage, cross-tether or other device which will prevent the animal from falling from, being thrown from, or jumping from the motor vehicle.

- (b) No person shall leave an animal in an unattended motor vehicle without adequate ventilation and in such a manner as to subject the animal to extreme temperatures or conditions which adversely affect the animal's health or welfare.
- (c) As used herein, the term "motor vehicle" includes a trailer or any other vehicle defined in the California Vehicle Code.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
