AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-16649 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. O-16683 (NEW SERIES); BY AMENDING SECTION 1. THEREOF RELATING TO ADJUSTING COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO THE RATE AUTHORIZED FOR FISCAL YEAR 1985-86.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. O-16649 (New Series) on May 27, 1986; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance establishes a schedule of compensation for officers and employees of The City of San Diego for fiscal year 1986-87; and

WHEREAS, section 1. of said ordinance relates to the establishment of compensation for the legislative body; and

WHEREAS, recited therein is the acknowledgement that recommendations thereon had been submitted by the Salary Setting Commission by report dated February 14, 1986, for fiscal years 1986-87 and 1987-88, and the provision that the Council shall take appropriate action thereon in connection with its deliberations and anticipated action upon the annual appropriation ordinance; and

WHEREAS, since the conditions of said Ordinance No. O-16649 (New Series) in this respect had been complied with, the Council considered and took action on those recommendations submitted by the Salary Setting Commission, pursuant to its Charter sections 12.1 and 24.1 mandate; and

WHEREAS, the action by Council included an increase in compensation for the position of Mayor from \$50,000 to \$55,000 per annum; and

WHEREAS, said increase was enacted by Council, pursuant to provisions of the Charter, during the period said position was vacant; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor thereafter pledged and did run for said office at the then existing annual salary, indicating opposition to any increase for said position of Mayor; and

WHEREAS, it has been requested and is necessary to amend said salary ordinance as it relates to the position of Mayor to adjust the per annum salary to the rate of \$50,000; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16645 (New Series) dated May 27, 1986, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1986-87" as amended by Ordinance No. O-16683 (New Series) dated June 30, 1986 be and it is hereby amended by amending Section 1. thereof to read as follows:

Section 1. LEGISLATIVE BODY, COMPENSATION ESTABLISHED.

Pursuant to Section 12.1 of the Charter of The City of San Diego and the recommendation of the Salary Setting Commission as contained in its report to the Mayor and City Council, dated February 14, 1986, there is hereby established and

adopted a schedule of compensation for Council Members for the period July 1, 1986 through June 30, 1987, as follows:

Council Member \$40,000 per annum

Pursuant to Section 24.1 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, the recommendation of the Salary Setting Commission, recited above, pertaining to the position of Mayor and adjustment to per annum salary therefor is acknowledged and reduced, it being the intent of Council to maintain an annual rate of pay for the position of Mayor at \$50,000.00 so long as the present Mayor holds such position during the term for which she was elected. In the event a new Mayor assumes said position, under any circumstance, the per annum rate of pay for said position of Mayor shall be automatically readjusted to reflect that level set forth in the recommendation of the Salary Setting Commission, contained in its report dated February 14, 1986, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 16740

The Auditor and Comptroller shall calculate and establish a table which shall be and is hereby adopted as the appropriate table of biweekly salaries most closely approximating the above authorized per annum compensation. The City Attorney is hereby directed to include the second

incremental increase for the Council, as recommended and adopted, in the fiscal year 1988 salary ordinance, unless otherwise directed by Council.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-16678 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1986-87 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NOS. 00-16678-1 AND NO. 00-16678-2, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY TRANSFERRING THE SUM OF \$14,998,462 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUND BALANCE OF THE SEWERAGE UTILITY REVENUE FUND (41506); AMENDING SECTION 2, SUBSECTION VI, ITEM 3, ENTITLED "SEWERAGE UTILITY REVENUE FUND (41506)" TO INCREASE NON-PERSONAL EXPENSE AND TOTAL BY SAID \$14,998,462; AND DIRECTING THE AUDITOR AND COMPTROLLER TO SET ASIDE, TRANSFER AND ALLOCATE THE \$14,998,462 APPROPRIATED ABOVE AS FOLLOWS: TO THE SEWERAGE UTILITY REVENUE FUND, UNALLOCATED RESERVE THE SUM OF \$2,908,482 AND TO THE WASTEWATER CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM (70492), CIP NO. 48-118.0, SEWER PUMP STATION 64 AND FORCE MAIN, THE SUM OF \$12,090,000.
