AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-16649 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1986-87," BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. OO-16649-1 AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY AMENDING EXHIBIT B TO SAID ORDINANCE ONLY TO CHANGE THE TITLES OF LIFEGUARD LIEUTENANT AND CAPTAIN TO MARINE SAFETY LIEUTENANT AND CAPTAIN RESPECTIVELY, ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SAID POSITIONS TO REMAIN UNCHANGED.

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission, at its regular meeting of August 7, 1986, approved a request of the Park and Recreation Director and the City Manager's Office to change the title of Lifeguard Lieutenant and Lifeguard Captain to Marine Safety Lieutenant and Marine Safety Captain; and

WHEREAS, the requested title changes are based on a recent restructuring of the functions within the lifeguard service to incorporate the duties previously performed by the Harbor Patrol classifications; and

WHEREAS, as a result, the Park and Recreation Department, supported by the City Manager's Office proposed retitling the higher level administrative classifications in the lifeguard service in order to more appropriately reflect the varied marine safety functions which will be supervised; and

WHEREAS, lower level field classifications will retain their present and well recognized lifeguard titles in order to avoid


the possibility of public confusion on the beaches; NOW,
THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16649 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1986-87" be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-16649-1, as amended and adopted therein, by amending Exhibit B to said ordinance only to retitle the positions of Lifeguard Lieutenant and Lifeguard Captain to read "Marine Safety Lieutenant" and "Marine Safety Captain" respectively, all other terms and conditions for said positions to remain unchanged.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


