WHEREAS, The City Clerk is assigned responsibility for the Records Management Program under Article II, Division 26 of the San Diego Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, a major component of the Records Management Program is the preparation of Records Disposition Schedules for City departments; and

WHEREAS, record inventories necessary for the preparation of Records Disposition Schedules remain to be done for ten City departments; and

WHEREAS, City staffing and funding limitations preclude the expeditious and early completion of these ten departmental record inventories; and

WHEREAS, record inventories and Records Disposition Schedules are required in order to properly identify and locate archival records; and

WHEREAS, City Council Policy 000-25 directs the Records

Management Officer to supervise the operation of a City Archives

for the collection, storage, preservation and presentation of

historically significant City records; and

WHEREAS, the proper operation of an Archives requires the services of a specially trained individual acting as an Archivist; and

WHEREAS, City funding limitations have heretofore precluded the hiring and employment of an Archivist; and

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WHEREAS, the National Historical Publications and Records
Commission through its national historical records program has
funded proposals for the development of improved local government
records programs, proposals for surveys of records not in
archives, and/or proposals for the establishment of new archival
programs; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Clerk is hereby authorized to submit an application to the National Historical Publications and Records Commission, said application to request funding over a two year period sufficient to (1) hire personnel to inventory the records of ten City departments and to complete Records Disposition Schedules for those departments, and (2) to hire and employ an archivist to establish an Archival Records Program to ensure the protection and preservation of City archival records.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the application for funding from the National Historical Publications and Records Commission shall be on file in the Clerk's office as Document No. RR-264839.
