WHEREAS, the federal government, by the Comprehensive Crime Control Act of 1984, has created provisions for equitable sharing with state and local law enforcement agencies of assets seized and forfeited for certain criminal violations, and

WHEREAS, guidelines pertaining to the disposition of forfeited property have been promulgated by the United States Attorney General, and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department has and will continue to participate in joint criminal investigation with federal and other law enforcement agencies resulting in seizure and forfeiture of assets, then therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to request, for and on behalf of said City, equitable transfer under the provisions of the Comprehensive Crime Control Act of 1984 and the guidelines promulgated thereto, of forfeited property seized during operations which included participation by the San Diego Police Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proceeds of all assets received by the City through the Federal Forfeiture Program be deposited into a special account in the General Fund to be used solely for investigation, detection and prosecution of criminal

activities and for the payment of any expenses necessary to seize, detain, inventory, maintain, and sell any property forfeited under federal law, with appropriations to be made from time to time in accordance with the City Charter and appropriate ordinances.
