RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 265051

ADOPTED ON FEB 11 1986

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager is hereby directed to initiate the design of a traffic signal at 42nd and Market Streets as soon as possible, with design to be completed by April, 1986.

2. That the City Manager is hereby directed to program a traffic signal at 42nd and Market Streets into the Capital Improvement Program for construction in FY'87 with total cost estimated at about \$90,000 to \$100,000.

3. That the City Manager is hereby directed to prepare bids for the award of a construction contract for a traffic signal at 42nd and Market Streets in July, 1986, with an approximate completion date in September, 1986.

4. That the City Manager is hereby requested to prepare for an accelerated construction schedule for the traffic signal to allow for an 8-week construction schedule, which will add to the cost of the traffic signal total cost estimate \$90,000 to \$100,000.

5. That the City Manager is hereby requested to implement Manager's recommendations 2, 3, and 4 contained in Manager's Report No. 86-52 to Transportation and Land Use Committee as follows:

a. Prohibit parking on Market Street at all of the intersections between 40th and 43rd Streets in order to provide increased vehicular and pedestrian visibility. (Approximately 35 parking spaces of the existing 85 spaces on Market Street will be removed.)

b. Provide supplementary 30 mph signs with 30 mph pavement legends at intermediate locations along Market Street between Boundary Street and I-805.

c. Institute a pedestrian safety awareness program in the neighborhood.


6. That the City Manager is hereby requested to prohibit on-street parking on 42nd and Market Streets, as necessary, for the installation of a traffic signal at 42nd and Market Streets as described in Manager's Report No. 86-52.

7. That the City Manager is hereby requested to meet with District 4 Councilmember and staff concerning appropriate median and/or striping on Market Street between Boundary Street and I-805.

8. That the City Manager is hereby requested to meet with neighborhood merchants and/or residents in the affected area, concerning appropriate median and/or striping on Market Street between Boundary Street and I-805.

9. That the City Manager is hereby requested to maintain continued police enforcement until the traffic signal and other improvements are completed.
