WHEREAS, scores of Soviet Jews are imprisoned in Soviet jails for wanting to live as Jews in the Soviet Union or emigrate to Israel; and

WHEREAS, we, in the United States, vehemently protest the division of families in the Soviet Union by Russian emigration policies and the persecution of religious and political minorities in the Soviet Union; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council does hereby join with the people of San Diego in welcoming Anatoly Shcharansky to freedom and calling upon the Soviet government to open the gates for free emigration.
