WHEREAS, California voters have adopted growth control measures in response to urban sprawl; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City voters overwhelmingly approved
Proposition A in November 1985, a growth control initiative,
which prohibits the City Council from removing land in the City's
urban reserve without voter approval; and

WHEREAS, Assemblyman Gil Ferguson has introduced AB 2907 which might effect Proposition A by nullifying any local zoning ordinance regulation which "has the effect of denying or limiting the development of housing," unless the measure is "necessary to achieve a vital and pressing governmental interest;" and

WHEREAS, it is inappropriate for the Legislature to attempt to obstruct the will of San Diego City voters; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of The City of San
Diego opposes AB 2907 and directs the Intergovernmental Relations
Department to express this opposition to the appropriate
legislative and administrative bodies in Sacramento.
