WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego held a public hearing to consider the amendment of the MIDWAY COMMUNITY PLAN; and

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego, by majority vote, approved the amendment of the MIDWAY COMMUNITY PLAN; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

- 1. That this Council hereby approves the amendment of that plan entitled MIDWAY COMMUNITY PLAN, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-265231.
- 2. That the amendment of the MIDWAY COMMUNITY PLAN shall become effective upon adoption of an appropriate amendment of the PROGRESS GUIDE AND GENERAL PLAN FOR THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO incorporating said plans at the next scheduled omnibus hearing.
