RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO EXECUTE A FREEWAY  
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND STATE FOR STATE  
ROUTE 52 FROM INTERSTATE 805 TO SANTO ROAD.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council proposes and intends to enter into an agreement with the State of California to order the following work to be done and improvements to be made for a freeway in said City under the provisions of sections 100.2 and 100.22 of the California Streets and Highways Code.

Section 1

DESCRIPTION OF AGREEMENT

This amendment to the freeway agreement between the City of San Diego and the State of California (CALTRANS) entered into on July 3, 1975 relating to state highway 52 will provide for a revised plan map for the location of Route 52. The revised plan map calls for the closure of certain City streets and frontage roads. The State of California (CALTRANS) agrees to acquire property in accordance with the revised plan. For further reference to the specific details of the proposed right-of-way, street closures and acquisitions, reference should be made to the specific plans affixed to the agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 265272 .

Section 2

TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on April 8, 1986 at 10:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, Community Concourse, 202 C Street, in the City of San Diego, California, is the day, hour and place for the hearing when and where any and all persons having any objections or protests as to the proposed work or improvement, to the grades at which the work is to be done, or to the extent of the district to be assessed, may appear and show cause why the proposed improvement should not be carried out in accordance with the Resolution of Intention; failure to make objections at that time shall be deemed to be a waiver of all objections and shall operate as a bar for any claim for damages arising from the City's decision to execute the agreement.

Such protest, if any, must be in writing and must contain a description of the property in which each signer thereof is interested, sufficient to identify the same and shall be delivered to and filed with the City Clerk.

Section 3


PUBLICATION OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION

The City Clerk is directed to cause this Resolution of Intention to be published twice at least ten days before the date of the hearing in the City Official Newspaper.

The City Clerk is directed to mail notices of the adoption of this Resolution of Intention, postage prepaid, to all persons owning real property proposed to be assessed, whose names and

addresses appear on the last equalized County Assessment Roll,  
all in the manner and form provided for under California Streets  
and Highways Code, Sections 5070, 5194 and 5195.


