WHEREAS, on April 21, 1986, the City Council considered alternate resolutions [R-86-1993 and R-86-2000] relating to the San Diego Convention Center; and

WHEREAS, the Council adopted R-86-2000 with the additional proviso that the new bidding process address the minority hiring standards and include the alternate priorities package referred to by Mr. Liegler, attached hereto as Attachment A; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that in respect to the San Diego Convention Center, the Board of Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District be and they are hereby urged to:

- 1. Retain the current design for the Convention Center;
- 2. Put out the project for rebid requesting two estimates, one for a twenty-six-month construction time line and the other for a thirty-month construction time line;
- 3. Select the twenty-six-month construction time estimate if there is not a significant cost savings realized; and
- 4. Retain the services of an experienced construction manager who possesses expertise in the construction of large scale public works projects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners are also urged to consider in the new bidding process the subject of minority hiring standards and further include the alternates priorities package attached hereto as Attachment A.
