RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER
CONCURRENCE WITH FINDINGS OF OVERCROWDING BY
THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE SWEETWATER UNION
HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That this Council proposes to consider concurrence with findings of overcrowding made by the governing board of the SWEETWATER UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT.

2. That pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 4.7 (commencing with Section 65970) of Division 1 of Title 7 of the California Government Code and the provisions of the San Diego Municipal Code, Section 98.0401 et seq., the City Council may establish Impacted Attendance Areas in concurrence with documented findings of the governing board of a school district that conditions of overcrowding, reasonably related to new development, exist, that all reasonable methods of mitigating the conditions of overcrowding have been evaluated, and no feasible methods for relieving those conditions exist.

3. That prior to determining its concurrence or nonconcurrence with a school district's findings, the City is required by Section 65971 of the above-cited chapter, division and title of the California Government Code, to make the findings available to the public for 60 days after the school district completes the documentation and files it with the City Council.

4. If the City Council concurs in the findings of the school district and establishes an Impacted Attendance Area covering the area designated by the school district, then no building permit shall be issued for residential development with such Impacted Attendance Area unless the applicant pays school fees or otherwise meets the requirements set forth in Municipal Code Section 98.0401, et seq.

TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on June 9, 1986 at 2:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, Community Concourse, 202 C Street, in the City of San Diego, California, is the day, hour and place for the hearing when any person interested may comment on the actions proposed to be taken by the City Council, as follows:

a. Concurrence with the findings of the governing board of the SWEETWATER UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT, as follows:

(1) That conditions of overcrowding exist in one or more attendance areas within the district which impair the normal functioning of educational programs, including the reasons for the existence of those conditions; and


(2) That all reasonable methods of mitigating the conditions of overcrowding have been evaluated and no feasible methods for relieving those conditions exist;

b. Establishment of an Impacted Attendance Area covering the area designated by the school district, and, consequently, activation of the requirements of Municipal Code Section 98.0416 with regard to the payment of school fees, or other requirements, as a condition of the issuance of a building permit within that Impacted Attendance Area; and

c. Determination of the schedule for the amount of school fees, or other requirements, to be paid as a condition of the issuance of a building permit within that Impacted Attendance Area, unless the residential development is exempt from the requirements of Municipal Code Section 98.0417.
