A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 1986, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE.

MAY 05 , 1986, the Council indicated its intention to submit to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego a proposition amending the Charter of The City of San Diego to prohibit the construction or operation of onshore facilities in support of certain offshore oil and gas drilling and pumping at a special municipal election to be held in the City on November 4, 1986; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that this special municipal election be consolidated with the statewide general election to be held on the same date and that within the City of San Diego the election precincts, polling places, voting booths and election officials for the two elections be the same, and that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego be authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal election and that this special municipal election and the statewide general election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, this Council within the time required by law has or will adopt an ordinance calling for a special municipal election

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate the special municipal election to be held in the City of San Diego on November 4, 1986 with the statewide general election to be held on the same date, November 4, 1986.
- 2. The exact form of the proposition to be voted upon at this special municipal election and as it is to appear on the ballot is as follows:

PROPOSITION AMENDS THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO BY ADDING SECTION 2.1. Neither the City Council nor any officer or employee of the City shall take any action, or permit any action to be taken, which directly or indirectly authorizes or permits the construction, YES operation or maintenance of any pipeline within the City for the transmission of any crude oil or natural gas taken or removed from any offshore crude oil or natural gas drilling or pumping operations within 100 nautical miles of the coastline of the County of San Diego; nor shall the City Council or any officer or employee of the City take any action, or permit any action to be taken, which directly or indirectly authorizes or permits the construction, operation or maintenance of any commercial or industrial facility with-NO in the City, including but not necessarily limited to crude oil or natural gas storage facilities, which operates directly or indirectly in support of any offshore crude oil or natural gas drilling or pumping operations within 100 nautical miles of the coastline of the County of San Diego.

The proposition shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of each measure as provided in Section 10219 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

- That the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of this special municipal election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.
- That the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the statewide general election appropriate instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of a consolidated election.
- That the City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.
