## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 265702 ADOPTED ON MAY 1 2 1986

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee on May 5, 1986 considered IRD Report No. 86-26 which analyzed the following measures which deal with ocean water quality: AB 3500, AB 3501, AB 3502, AB 3503, AB 3504, AB 3505, AB 3506, AB 3739, AB 3802, AB 3804, AB 3976, AB 4044, AB 4155, SB 1925, AB 2190, and SB 2495; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee voted to accept IRD's recommendations regarding all the bills except AB 3606; and WHEREAS, the Rules Committee now forwards the matter to the full Council for action; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City supports AB 3500 if amended to define "short term degradation", "long-term degradation", "indigenous marine life", and "threat to human health".
- 2. That the City supports AB 3501 and directs IRD to seek amendments to define "marine pollution" to be the presence of contaminants in amounts which could cause harm to human health.
  - 3. That the City takes no position on AB 3502.
- 4. That the City supports AB 3503 if it is amended to define ocean pollution to mean California coastal water contaminated in amounts that cause harm to humans, state fisheries or unreasonably degrades the existing beneficial uses of state coastal waters.

- 5. That the City supports AB 3504 if it is amended to specify that it does not subject government employers to liability.
  - 6. That the City supports AB 3505.
- 7. That AB 3506 is continued for two weeks with instruction to the Personnel Department to draft an amendment that would require government employees to carry out reporting duties.
  - 8. That the City take no position on AB 3739.
- 9. That the City supports AB 3802 so long as increased staff is assigned to offshore oil-related issues.
- 10. That consideration of AB 3804 be postponed until the author's legislative intent is clarified.
  - 11. That the City supports AB 3976.
  - 12. That the City supports AB 4044.
  - 13. That the City supports AB 4155.
  - 14. That the City supports SB 1925.
  - 15. That the City supports SB 2190.
  - 16. That the City supports SB 2495.
