RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 265751

ADOPTED ON MAY 20 1986

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS THE MARINA "G" BLOCKS (HARBOR DRIVE TO MARKET STREET, UNION STREET TO 4TH AVENUE) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R- 265496, a public hearing was called for on MAY 20 1986 at the hour of 10:00 A.M. in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, to determine whether the public health, safety or general welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within that certain area of the City of San Diego more particularly described as follows:

The northerly half of Lot A, and all of Lots G through L in Block 25, Lots K and L in Block 13 in New San Diego, Map 456; Lots A through D and G through L in Block A, Lots A through L in Block B, Lots A through L in Block 92, Lots A through L in Block 93, Lots A through F in Block 94, Lots C through J in Block 115, Lots A through L in Block 116, Lots A through L in Block 117, Lots A, K and L in Block 118, Lots A through D and G through L in Block 119, Lots A through L in Block 120, the westerly half of Lots A through F in Block 121, the westerly half of Lots A through D in Block 140, Lots K and L in Block 141, all in Horton's Addition, Lockling Deed Book 13, Page 522.

Said district shall also include the following described public rights-of-way:

The southerly half of MARKET STREET between the easterly line of Union Street and a line parallel to and 100 feet west of the westerly line of Fourth Avenue; ISLAND AVENUE between a line parallel to and 100 feet west of the westerly line of Front Street and a line parallel to and 50 feet east of the easterly line of Third Avenue; "J" STREET between a line 50 feet east of the easterly line of Fourth Avenue and the westerly line of First Avenue; "K" STREET between a line parallel to and 50 feet east of the easterly line of Fourth Avenue and the westerly line of Third Avenue; FRONT STREET between the northerly line of Island Avenue and the southerly line of Market Street; FIRST AVENUE between the southerly line of "J" Street and the southerly line of Market Street; SECOND AVENUE between the southerly line of Market Street and a line parallel to and 150 feet south of the southerly line of "J" Street; THIRD AVENUE between the southerly line of Market Street and the southerly line of "K" Street; FOURTH AVENUE between a line parallel to and 100 feet south of the southerly line of Island Avenue and a line parallel to and 175 feet south of the southerly line of "K" Street; all as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 22557-D entitled "MARINA "G" BLOCKS (HARBOR DRIVE TO MARKET STREET, UNION STREET TO 4TH AVENUE) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT," copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 265496 and attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given by the City Clerk to all affected property owners as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Council does hereby find and determine that the public health, safety and general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above and that pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the above-described area is hereby declared to be an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the maps and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.

2. The City Council shall by subsequent resolution fix the date upon which the property in the district must be ready to receive underground service, and shall by subsequent resolution order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service.

3. The City Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. The City Clerk shall further notify said affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service they shall provide at their own expense all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California (as of the date of adoption of this resolution) and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.
