RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 265868

ADOPTED ON JUN 2 1986

WHEREAS, Section 67.55 of the San Diego Municipal Code provides that water service charges shall be established by resolution of the City Council upon the giving of ten (10) days' notice of intention to establish, amend or increase said charges; and

WHEREAS, Section 67.59 of the San Diego Municipal Code provides that fire service and automatic fire sprinkler service charges shall be established by resolution of the City Council upon the giving of ten (10) days' notice of intention to establish, amend or increase said charges; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 67.05 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the City Manager has recommended that certain monthly fees charged for maintaining and replacement of backflow prevention devices be increased; and

WHEREAS, Section 67.72 of the San Diego Municipal Code provides that minimum water capacity charges may be established by resolution of the City Council upon the giving of ten (10) days' notice of intention to establish, amend or increase said charges; and

WHEREAS, said notice has been given by posting the intention to increase said charges by the City Clerk; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That pursuant to Section 67.55 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the following monthly water service charges are established:

(1) Customer Charge, per meter:

(2) In addition to the Customer Charge above, there shall be a Commodity Charge for each unit of 100 cubic feet of water delivered:

That pursuant to Section 67.59 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the following monthly fire service and automatic fire sprinkler service charges are established:

That pursuant to Section 67.05 of the San Diego Municipal Code, maintenance and replacement fees for backflow prevention devices shall be as follows:

AS OF 7/1/86:

- a. \$1.13 per month for each backflow prevention device which is 5/8, 3/4, 1, 1-1/2 or 2 inches in size.
- b. \$2.26 per month for each backflow prevention device which is 3, 4 or 6 inches in size.
- c. \$3.39 per month for each backflow prevention device which is 8, 10, 12 inches or larger in size.

AS OF 7/1/87:

- a. \$1.28 per month for each backflow prevention device which is 5/8, 3/4, 1, 1-1/2 or 2 inches in size.
- b. \$2.56 per month for each backflow prevention device which is 3, 4 or 6 inches in size.
- c. \$3.84 per month for each backflow prevention device which is 8, 10, 12 inches or larger in size.

A dual backflow prevention device unit shall be charged a monthly fee one and one-half times that charged for one of the single backflow prevention devices that compose the unit.

That pursuant to Section 67.72 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the following minimum water capacity charges are established:

EFFECTIVE 7/1/86:

A minimum capacity charge of Three Hundred Ninety Three Dollars (\$393.00) per single family unit or equivalent shall be paid. This charge shall be subject to simple interest of six percent (6%) from July 1, 1986, to and including that date the charge is paid.

In those areas of the City where a capacity charge in the form of area charges as established by Council resolution, or taxation, or special assessment districts excluding 1911 and 1913 Act assessment districts, results in a payment to the City totaling more than Three Hundred Ninety Three (\$393.00) plus accrued interest per single family unit or its equivalent, no new capacity charge shall be imposed by this section. However, charges imposed due to reimbursement agreements entered into by the City shall be collected where applicable in every case.


EFFECTIVE 7/1/87:

A minimum capacity charge of Five Hundred Sixty Five Dollars (\$565.00) per single family unit or equivalent shall be paid. This charge shall be subject to simple interest of six percent (6%) from July 1, 1987, to and including that date the charge is paid.

In those areas of the City where a capacity charge in the form of area charges as established by Council resolution, or taxation, or special assessment districts excluding 1911 and 1912 Act assessment districts, results in a payment to the City totaling more than Five Hundred Sixty Five Dollars (\$565.00) plus accrued interest per single family unit or its equivalent, no new capacity charge shall be imposed by this section. However, charges imposed due to reimbursement agreements entered into by the City shall be collected where applicable in every case.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be effective and in force on the first day of July, 1986.
