WHEREAS, State law requires the California Highway Patrol (CHP) to adopt regulations specifying routes to be used for the transportation of hazardous radioactive materials; and

WHEREAS, the CHP's draft proposal designates I-5, I-8, I-15 and SR163 in San Diego for the transportation of these materials; and

WHEREAS, the CHP will hold a public hearing in San Diego on June 5, 1986, on this designation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on June 2, 1986 on this designation; and

WHEREAS, SR163 has three schools and a hospital within a half mile radius; and

WHEREAS, I-15 north of I-8 to the juncture with SR163 is not within a half mile radius of schools and hospitals, and is a shorter route; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council recommends to the CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL that it amend its proposed designated routes for transportation of radioactive material to be I-15 all the way from I-8 north to the City boundary, and recommends approval of the other proposed routes, I-5 and I-8.
