RESOLUTION OF CONCURRENCE WITH FINDINGS OF OVERCROWDING IN THE SAN YSIDRO SCHOOL DISTRICT; ESTABLISHMENT OF AN IMPACTED ATTENDANCE AREA, AND ESTABLISHMENT OF A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR INTERIM SCHOOL FACILITIES FINANCING TO BE PAID AS A PRECONDITION TO THE ISSUANCE OF A RESIDENTIAL BUILDING PERMIT.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That this Council concurs with findings made by the governing board of the SAN YSIDRO SCHOOL DISTRICT, pursuant to their Resolution No. 21, dated April 14, 1986, that conditions of overcrowding, reasonably related to new development, exist; that these conditions impair the normal functioning of educational programs; and that all reasonable methods of mitigating the conditions of overcrowding have been evaluated, and no feasible methods for relieving those conditions exist.
- 2. That pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 4.7

 (commencing with Section 65970) of Division 1 of Title 7 of the California Government Code and the provisions of the San Diego Municipal Code, Section 98.0401, et seq., the City Council hereby establishes an Impacted Attendance Area covering the area designated by the governing board of the SAN YSIDRO SCHOOL DISTRICT according to the map filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 266011

3. That pursuant to the provisions of the San Diego Municipal Code, Section 98.0418, the City Council establishes the following fee schedule based on the cost per pupil to provide an acceptable temporary school facility, prorated on the basis of the pupil yield for the type of housing within the Impacted Attendance Area, as follows:

> For each multi-family residential unit: \$1,918 For each single-family residential unit: \$1,918 For each mobile-home unit:

That the City Council declares that no residential 4. building permit shall be issued for residential development within such Impacted Attendance Area unless the applicant pays school fees or otherwise meets the requirements set forth in
