RESOLUTION NUMBER R-266028

ADOPTED ON JUNE 17, 1986

WHEREAS, in January 1981, Patrick W. Moore came to San Diego and assumed the position of Executive Director of the Regional Employment and Training Consortium (RETC), a joint powers agency of the City and County of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Moore successfully directed the complex transition from the programs of the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA) to the programs of the Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA); and

WHEREAS, Mr. Moore assisted in the formation of the Private Industry Council (PIC), a partnership of business and industry leaders interested in enhancing local job opportunities for unemployed and disadvantaged persons, while simultaneously assuring local employers of available and trained workers; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Moore served as President of PIC; and

WHEREAS, as the chief administration officer of RETC and PIC, Mr. Moore was responsible for the creation and implementation of dozens of unique and highly successful employment and training programs for the benefit of unemployed and disadvantaged residents of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure as Executive Director of RETC and President of PIC, 66,000 San Diegans benefitted from employment training services provided by those agencies and secured gainful employment as a result thereof; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Moore is now moving on to accept new challenges
in private industry; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that
Patrick W. Moore be and he is hereby commended for efforts to
improve the economic conditions of unemployed and disadvantaged
San Diegans, thereby lessening governmental costs and improving
the overall economy of San Diego.
