

PROPOSITION F. INITIATIVE MEASURE. AMENDS THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO BY ADDING SECTION 130.1.		
The Council shall establish, for fiscal year 1986-1987, a base salary for the classification of Police Officer II, which is not less than the average base salary for comparable police officer positions in the California Highway Patrol and the police departments of the four (4) largest cities by population in the State of California. In	Y E S	
determining the average salaries, no California city will be considered if that city is required to use an averaging formula for determining police officer salaries. All other classifications in the police unit shall receive a percentage base salary increase equal to that for Police Officer II as determined in the above manner.  The establishment of salaries for police classifications using the above formula for fiscal year 1986-1987 shall not require an increase in the annual tax levy.	N O

Proposition E received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified voters voting on it and such proposition is hereby declared to have been approved.



PROPOSITION F

Against 98,518

TOTAL 162,366

Proposition F did not receive the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified voters voting on it and such proposition is hereby declared to have failed.
