## RESOLUTION NUMBER R-266805 ADOPTED ON OCTOBER 13, 1986

WHEREAS, the City Council is responsible for providing for the safety, health and general welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the City of San Diego to establish land and zoning uses; and

WHEREAS, the communities of the City of San Diego derive their economic and social viability from well coordinated land use planning; and

WHEREAS, the disposal of toxic waste is a serious issue which demands an environmentally safe solution; and

WHEREAS, there is at least one proposal under consideration by the Environmental Protection Agency regarding a toxic waste incineration project to be located in the limits of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has no formal process to review and approve the siting of firms involved in toxic waste management; and

WHEREAS, a formal toxic waste management permit process, administered by the City of San Diego, would insure City input relative to environmental concerns and consistency with the established land uses; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of The City of San Diego hereby requests the City Manager, City Attorney and Planning Department to examine and report back to this City Council on the

methods available for establishing a permitting process which would include environmental review for projects related to the development or implementation of toxic waste management technologies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney is requested to prepare an emergency ordinance for such a permitting process and its associated environmental review process for City Council consideration on October 28, 1986.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager in cooperation with the Director of the Planning Department is requested to prepare a letter for the Mayor's signature to the State of California Department of Health Services, the Environmental Protection Agency, and the Air Pollution Central District, which, inter alia, indicates that the City of San Diego is in the process of creating a permitting procedure which would be applicable to a proposal currently pending before their respective agencies (G. A. Technologies) and request them to allow the City of San Diego to act on this proposal before they exercise their permitting authority.
