RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 266817

ADOPTED ON OCT 14 1986

WHEREAS, the Historical Site Board of The City of San Diego on May 28, 1986, conducted a public hearing to determine whether the Green Dragon Colony, located at 1258-74 Prospect Street and 1241-43 Coast Boulevard, in the City of San Diego (Lots 30, 31, and 32 of Block 59, La Jolla Park Map No. 352), should be designated as a historical site pursuant to Section 26.02 of the San Diego Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, after taking testimony, discussion and deliberation, the Historical Site Board designated as historical, four buildings within the Green Dragon Colony (i.e., the Dolly Varden, East Cliff, Jack O'Lantern and Gables cottages at 1241 and 1243 Coast Boulevard and 1260 and 1268½ Prospect Street); and

WHEREAS, the property owner has appealed the historical designation of the four buildings within the Green Dragon Colony to the City Council pursuant to Section 26.02 of the San Diego Municipal Code; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has heard the appeal of the property owner from the decision of the Historical Site Board to designate as historic the four buildings within the Green Dragon Colony; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and considered the information and research materials considered by the Historical Site Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Council heard and considered public testimony and written correspondence on this matter; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that it hereby upholds the decision of the Historical Site Board to designate the four buildings within the Green Dragon Colony as historically and architecturally significant structures (i.e., the Dolly Varden, East Cliff, Jack O'Lantern and Gables cottages at 1241 and 1243 Coast Boulevard and 1260 and 1268 1/2 Prospect Street, respectively).
