ADOPTED ON NOV 3 1986

WHEREAS, the San Diego Commission on the Bicentennial of the United States Constitution was the first Bicentennial Community to be officially recognized by the National Commission; and

WHEREAS, the forthcoming Bicentennial of the United States Constitution coincides with exhibition of the original Magna Carta in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Magna Carta is the oldest written instrument of national government; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Commission has planned a full year of events for San Diego in 1987 to bring public attention to the Bicentennial commemoration; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Commission has established an education committee composed of distinguished educators in San Diego to insure that every student in public and private schools in San Diego County receive a special instructional curriculum next year on the constitution; and


WHEREAS, it is one of the San Diego Commission's goals to bring the Magna Carta, "Liberty of Law", exhibit which includes various historical documents, including the original King John Magna Carta dated 1215 and the Library of Congress' draft of the United States Constitution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council does hereby commend the San Diego Commission on the

Bicentennial of the United States Constitution for their efforts relative to the Bicentennial particularly as they relate to education of San Diego students.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this City Council does hereby strongly support the Commission's efforts to bring the "Magna Carta: Liberty of the Law" exhibit to San Diego in 1987.
