RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 2671C2 ADOPTED ON NOV 24 1986

WHEREAS, Section 8330, et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of streets by City Council resolution where the portion of the street and alley to be vacated for a period of five consecutive years has been impassable for vehicular travel and no public money was expended for maintenance on the street or alley during such period; and

WHEREAS, in connection with said vacation, the City desires to reserve certain easements; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have requested the vacation of Cedar Street between 39th Street and 40th Street and the portion of the north/south alley adjacent to Lots 7 through 10 in Block 21 of Marilou Park, Map 517 to facilitate development of their property; and

WHEREAS, the portion of street to be vacated is not needed for present or prospective public street purposes; and

WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the street to be vacated will continue to have access; and

WHEREAS, the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and

WHEREAS, the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That Cedar Street between 39th Street and 40th Street and the portion of the north/south alley adjacent to Lots 7 through 10 in Block 21 of Marilou Park, Map 517 as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 16783-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 267102-/, which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated.
- 2. That the City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts the right, easement, and privilege of placing, constructing, repairing, replacing, maintaining, using, and operating public utilities of any kind or nature, including, but not limited to, sewer and water facilities and all necessary and proper fixtures and equipment for use in connection therewith, through, over, under, upon, along, and across the hereinafter-described easement, together with the right of ingress thereto and egress therefrom, together with the right to maintain the said easement free and clear of any excavation or fills, the erection or construction of any building or other structures, the planting of any tree or trees thereon, or the drilling or digging of any well or wells thereon, together with the right to otherwise protect from all hazards the operation and use of any right hereby reserved. Upon acquisition of encroachment permit from the City Engineer pursuant to the Municipal Code of the City, the owners of the underlying fee may utilize the above-described parcel of land for structures, the planting or growing of trees, or the installation of privately owned pipelines. 
