AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 7,  
DIVISION 31, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE  
BY AMENDING SECTION 27.3102 RELATING TO  
SPECIAL MEETING TO CONSIDER THE ALTERNATIVE OF  
APPOINTMENT OR ELECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 7, Division 31, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 27.3102 to read as follows:

SEC. 27.3102 SPECIAL MEETING TO CONSIDER THE  
ALTERNATIVE OF APPOINTMENT OR ELECTION

As soon as it is known that there will be a vacancy in an elective office of The City of San Diego by reason of a resignation or that there exists a vacancy in such elective office by reason of a death or other unexpected circumstance, the presiding officer of the Council shall immediately call a special meeting of the Council to consider the question of whether the vacancy shall be filled by an appointment or an election. In the instance of resignation, a notification containing the effective date of resignation must be received in the office of the City Clerk for a vacancy to occur. Unless otherwise specified, a resignation is effective when received. If the determination is made to fill the position by appointment, the procedures provided for in this division shall be followed.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter of the City of San Diego, this ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
