ORDINANCE NUMBER O-16814 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON FEB 23 1987

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, ARTICLE 2, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING DIVISION 91, SECTIONS 52.9100, 52.9101, 52.9102, 52.9103, 52.9103, 52.9105, 52.9106 RELATING TO HOTELS, MOTELS, INNS, AUTO COURTS, TRAILER PARKS, TRANSIENT LODGING PLACES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter V, Article 2, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by adding Division 91, sections 52.9100, 52.9101, 52.9102, 52.9103, 52.9103, 52.9105, 52.9106 to read as follows:

DIVISION 91

**HOTELS, MOTELS, INNS, AUTO COURTS,
TRAILER PARKS, TRANSIENT LODGING PLACES**

SEC. 52.9100 POSTING OF RATES

Every manager or person in control of a hotel, motel, inn, boarding, lodging or transient apartment house in the City of San Diego shall post in a conspicuous place in each room or apartment which is for rent or hire a printed statement of the specific charge or rate of charges by the day, week or month to be charged for said room or rooms.

SEC. 52.9101 CHARGES IN EXCESS OF POSTED RATES PROHIBITED

No charge or sum shall be collected or received by any manager or person in control of a hotel, motel, inn, boarding, lodging or transient apartment house for any

greater sum than entitled to under the statement of charges or rates posted.

SEC. 52.9102 POSTING OF RULES AND REGULATIONS OF ESTABLISHMENTS

Every manager or person in control of a hotel, motel, inn, boarding, lodging or transient apartment house is hereby required to post in a conspicuous place in each room of such hotel, motel, inn, boarding, lodging or transient apartment house a printed statement of the general rules and regulations of said hotel, motel, inn, boarding, lodging or transient apartment house.

SEC. 52.9103 REGISTERS AT HOTELS, APARTMENT HOUSES, ROOMING HOUSES

Every manager or person in control of any hotel, motel, inn, boarding, loading, transient apartment house, or auto court or trailer park in the City of San Diego shall keep a register for the registration of transient guests. Such register shall be preserved for at least three (3) years and shall at all times be subject to inspection by any law enforcement officer of the City of San Diego.

SEC. 52.9104 REGISTRATION OF GUESTS

No manager or person in control of any hotel, motel, inn, boarding, loading, transient apartment house or auto court or a trailer park in the City of San Diego shall let or assign for temporary or transient occupancy any suite, room or bed thereof to any person or persons until they shall have registered their name and address in the register. The register shall show correctly the year, month, day and hour

of the arrival of such persons, the number of the suite or room assigned, the time of departure or, if the exact time of departure is not known, the date and time that the fact of the departure of each guest is ascertained. No person shall erase or alter, or suffer or permit to be erased or altered any of said entries in such register.

SEC. 52.9105 REGISTRATION OF VEHICLES AND TRAILERS

Every manager or person in control of any motel, auto park or trailer park shall enter in the register the make, type, license number and issuing state and name of registered owner of any motor vehicle or trailer in the immediate possession of any guest.

SEC. 52.9106 TRAILER PARKS - TRAILER FRONTING ON ROADWAY


It shall be unlawful for any person in a trailer park to use, install or cause or permit to be used or installed:

(a) Any trailer with the trailer hitch facing or fronting other than upon a roadway.

(b) Any obstructions between the trailer and the roadway on which it fronts which would prevent the prompt removal of the trailer in case of emergency.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on June 1, 1987, or on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, whichever shall be later.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, ARTICLE 2, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING DIVISION 91, SECTIONS 52.9100, 52.9101, 52.9102, 52.9103, 52.9105, 52.9108 RELATING TO HOTELS, MOTELS, INNS, AUTO COURTS, TRAILER PARKS, TRANSIENT LODGING PLACES.

This ordinance amends and renumbers sections of the San Diego Municipal Code which require hotels, motels, inns, auto courts, trailer parks and other transient lodging places to post their rates and rules and regulations in each unit and to maintain guest registers which are to be available for inspection. These provisions were formerly contained in Chapter III, Article 3, and are renumbered by this ordinance as a general police regulation rather than as a police regulated business activity.


