ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 16825 (New Series)

ADOPTED ON MAR 16 1987

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 16678 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1986-87" TO CREATE THE NEW POSITION OF POLICE PERSONNEL MANAGER; EXEMPTING SAID POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AMENDING EXHIBIT C TO SAID ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE SAID POSITION; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the personnel function in the San Diego Police Department (Police Department) has become increasingly complex in recent years, the work being governed by a multitude of laws and administrative regulations; and

WHEREAS, the practice of the Police Department to routinely reassign personnel captains has had a disruptive effect in that about the time that captains become technically proficient in the field, they are subject to movement within the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department requests that a non-sworn position of Police Personnel Manager be created in the unclassified service; and

WHEREAS, the creation of this position would enable the Police Department to bring in a professional in the field of personnel management at the level of police commander who would report directly to a deputy chief and would be responsible for managing the activities of the Personnel and Training and

Development Divisions and the Equal Employment Opportunity Unit, and would be the labor relations backup to the deputy chief of personnel services; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission reviewed the justification for the position on December 4, 1986 and has commented favorably; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the annual salary ordinance to create said position and establish an appropriate rate of compensation therefore; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 16678 (New Series), as amended entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1986-87" be and the same is hereby further amended by creating and establishing the position of Police Personnel Manager.


Section 2. That the position created in section 1 above be and the same is hereby exempted from the classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service of The City of San Diego, after favorable comment by the Civil Service Commission at its December 4, 1986 meeting.

Section 3. That said Ordinance No. 16678 (New Series) be and it is hereby further amended to amend Exhibit C thereto so as to reflect said position designation of Police Personnel Manager in Managerial Category III.

Section 4. As a schedule of compensation for the position established and enumerated in sections 1 and 2 above, the position of Police Personnel Manager is hereby authorized at salary ranges of 07.7, 07.8 and 07.9.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
