AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. O-16413 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED APRIL 23, 1985, RELATING TO THE BUILDING LIMITATIONS IN THE UNIVERSITY COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, the existing recommendations and implementing mechanisms in the University Community Plan (1983) have not been effective in reducing levels of traffic congestion associated with the rapid development of said community; and

WHEREAS, traffic volumes on the major roads will continue to increase in relation to their present design capacities; and

WHEREAS, the construction of new commercial and residential development has accelerated during the recent two-year period; and

WHEREAS, under present zoning, potential development could greatly exceed community plan levels based upon a 1980 Land Use Forecast; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is committed to the study and development of permanent solutions to the problems of traffic congestion; and

WHEREAS, continued development in excess of levels assumed by the University Community Plan, as identified in the 1980 Land Use Forecast (Appendix 3), could impair the ability of The City of San Diego to implement solutions which are in the interest of the public health, safety and general welfare; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code Section 9101 empowers the City

Council to limit or prohibit the issuance of any type, number or

geographic distribution of permits where such issuance would

detrimentally affect the health, safety or general welfare of the

citizens of The City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the present ordinance will expire on April 1, 1987, and its replacement will not be in effect; and

WHEREAS, the lapse of this ordinance would allow building permits to be issued which would detrimentally affect the health, safety or general welfare of the citizens of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 0-16413 (New Series), adopted April 23, 1985, be and the same are hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That within the boundaries of the University Community Plan, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-16413, no building permits shall be issued for the construction, alteration or expansion of any structure unless:

(a) A Planned Development or Specific Plan is considered by the Planning Commission and approved by the City Council and participation in the Facilities Benefit Assessment Program is assured; or

- (b) Building permits for buildings are found by the Planning Department to be consistent with the University Community Plan and the 1980 Land Use Forecast (Appendix 3); or
- (c) Building permit applications are for the construction of the Scripps Molecular Biological Building addition and associated parking structure, and participation in the Facilities Benefit Assessment Program, commitment to traffic improvements as required by the City Engineer are assured; or
- (d) Building permit applications are for the construction of an automobile dealership of approximately 33,500 square feet on a portion of Lot 2, Section 10, Township 15 South, Range 3 West, S.B.B.M., in the City of san Diego, California (Miramar Industrial Tract Unit 9, Map No. 10867), and participation in the Facilities Benefit Assessment Program and commitment to traffic improvements as required by the City Engineer and insulation of office spaces to ensure that office workers are not exposed to interior noise levels exceeding 50db CNEL are assured. Site plan approval in accordance with the requirements of the Planned Industrial Development Permit process by the Planning Director shall also be required.

Section 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall be in force and effect until Ordinance No. 0-16837 (New Series), amending Ordinance No. 0-16413 (New Series) becomes effective.

Section 2. This ordinance shall, for the reasons set forth in the preamble hereto, constitute an emergency imterim ordinance and shall become effective immediately upon its introduction and adoption by the City Council.
