

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 16841 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON APR 6 1987

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-16695 (NEW SERIES), DATED AUGUST 11, 1986, LIMITING THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS WHICH REQUIRE SEWER HOOKUPS IN THE SEWER PUMP STATION NO. 64 SERVICE AREA WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16695 (New Series) be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. No change.

Section 2. Upon the occurrence of any of the foregoing events, the City Manager shall be responsible for causing the immediate cessation of the issuance of building permits, except that the City Manager may continue to issue building permits for:

- a) Remodeling an existing structure;
- b) Completion of interior or exterior work (tenant improvements);
- c) Structures that will not be connected to the City's sewage disposal system such as model homes and warehouses;
- d) Single family residence which will be occupied by the owner/builder;
- e) Buildings served by an alternative sewage disposal system certified by the Health Department of the County of San Diego;

Thereafter, at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council, the City Manager shall report the basis for his actions. The City Council shall, by resolution after conducting a hearing, approve or reject the City Manager's action.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage and shall continue in force until November 15, 1987.
