AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND SANTA FE LAND IMPROVEMENT COMPANY.

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego (the "City") has heretofore entered into a certain Development Agreement (Document No. OO-15954) with the Santa Fe Land Improvement Company ("Santa Fe"); and

WHEREAS, the City did amend the Development Agreement by Ordinance No. O-16566 (New Series) on December 16, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the City and Santa Fe desire to amend the Development Agreement and to make certain other changes deemed appropriate by the parties thereby extending the time for two (2) additional years to six (6) years within which the Local Coastal Program shall be filed; and

WHEREAS, after due notice, the City Council did conduct a public hearing on this matter wherein all persons desiring to be heard were heard; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and considered the Second Amendment and determined the content of the Second Amendment to be complete and correct; and

WHEREAS, the Second Amendment is in the public interest and is consistent with the City's Progress Guide and General Plan ("General Plan") and the Redevelopment Plan for the Columbia Redevelopment Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council finds and determines the facts stated above to be true.

Section 2. The City Council further finds with respect to the Second Amendment, that:

- A. It is consistent with the objectives, policies, programs and uses specified in the General Plan and the Redevelopment Plan for the Columbia Redevelopment Project.
- B. It will not be detrimental to the public health, safety and general welfare.
- C. It will promote the orderly development of property or the preservation of property values in accordance with good land use practice.

Section 3. The City Council hereby approves the Second Amendment, and authorizes and directs the City Manager to execute said Second Amendment in the name of The City of San Diego not later than fifteen (15) days following the effective date of this ordinance. Failure of Santa Fe to execute the Second Amendment within said fifteen (15) day period shall render this action null and void. The City Clerk is directed to record said Second Amendment and this ordinance with the County Recorder of San Diego County within ten (10) days after its execution.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth (30th) day from and after its passage.
