### ORDINANCE NO. <u>0-16928</u> (New Series)

### ADOPTED ON <u>AUG 11 1987</u>

### AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX RATES AND LEVYING TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1987-88.

WHEREAS, Section 75 of the Charter of the City of San Diego requires an annual tax levy be adopted by ordinance not later than the last day of August of each year; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 13 approved by the voters to be effective July 1, 1978 amended the State Constitution by adding Article XIIIA to limit the amount of ad valorem tax on real property; and

WHEREAS, as a result of Article XIIIA and the adoption of state legislation in concurrence thereto, the Charter provisions related to amount of tax and process of collection have been modified and superseded; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XIIIA and the accompanying state legislation, the annual tax levy is limited to those certain exceptions provided for in said Article XIIIA and Sections 2237, and 2237.1 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to the above recited provisions of law, it is required that the County of San Diego levy the annual ad valorem property tax, on the full value of said property, except as otherwise provided therein, and distribute it to the public agencies and districts within the County; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 75 of the Charter of the City of San Diego, Article XIIIA of the State Constitution and the state legislation adopted pursuant thereto, there is hereby fixed a rate of taxation of one cent and one and twenty one hundreths mills (\$0.01120) on each one hundred dollars' valuation of taxable property (full value) within the City of San Diego for the fiscal year 1987-88 and that the rate is hereby levied on all taxable property, both real and personal, in the City of San Diego. Included herein is the amount required to be levied by Section 77a of said Charter.

Section 2. An allowance of five and five tenths percent (5.5%) for anticipated delinquencies in tax payments upon real property and improvements thereon and personal property secured, other than properties of public utilities, is hereby established.

Section 3. The rate is computed as follows:



(1) Section 77a of the City Charter requires a two-cent tax levy on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation. Section 135 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code now defines "assessed value" as full value. Pursuant to Section 135(d) of the California Revenue and Taxation Code a conversion factor of one-fourth (1) is applied to the tax rate for purposes of expressing tax rates on the same basis. taxable property assessed at full value (100%) for FY 1987-88. This rate will be applied to

Section 4. Pursuant to the provisions of the San Diego Municipal Code, Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 12, Section 61.1201, and Resolution No. 201037 of the Council of the City of San Diego, adopted October 15, 1970, there is hereby fixed a rate of taxation of one cent and four and ten one hundreths mills (\$0.01410) on each one hundred dollars' land valuation of taxable property (full value) designated as Zone A within the Penasquitos Sewer Improvement District and a rate of taxation of two and eighty-two one hundreths mills (\$0.00282) on each one hundred dollars' land valuation of taxable property (full value) designated as Zone B within the Penasquitos Sewer Improvement District, and these rates are hereby levied on all taxable land in the Penasquitos Sewer Improvement District as shown on the assessment roll of the County of San Diego for the fiscal year 1987-88.

Section 5. An allowance of six percent (6.0%) for anticipated delinquencies in tax payments upon real property (land) in the Penasquitos Sewer Improvement District is hereby established.

Section 6. The rates have been computed as follows:

Section 8. This ordinance is declared to take effect immediately upon its passage, pursuant to the authority contained in Section 16 and 17 of the Charter of the City of San Diego.
