WHEREAS, the City Manager has requested the City Auditor and Comptroller to provide for significant computer system changes in the areas of Purchasing/Stores Inventory and Project Management (Cost Accounting); and

WHEREAS, the need for increased automation in the Purchasing Department was previously approved by Council and is consistent with the management audit findings of Hamm, O'Brien and Isler; and

WHEREAS, additionally, the City needs to develop new computer systems in the area of project management (cost accounting), particularly regarding capital projects and these systems should not proceed without adequate involvement of the Auditor's office as they are or will be integrally tied to, and must interface with, our existing fiscal systems; and

WHEREAS, for the next two years, the Auditor's existing staff is fully committed to the development of a new Personnel/Payroll System, necessitating this request for additional staff;

therefore, 1.00 Principal Accountant and 1.00 Accountant II positions are requested to promptly begin the development and implementation of the new systems being requested by the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the Principal Accountant position had been reviewed previously by the Civil Service Commission, commented upon favorably for exemption from the Classified Service, and approved by Council for inclusion in the Unclassified Service in the Managerial Category B; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual appropriation ordinance to effectuate said additions to staff; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16916 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1987-88 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-16916-1 as adopted and amended therein, by adding one (1.00) Principal Accountant position and one (1.00) Accountant II position.

Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, the Civil Service Commission had previously commented favorably upon the exemption from the Classified Service for the Principal Accountant and acted upon thereafter by the City Council, said exemption hereby declared to be in full force and effect.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the Principal Accountant position, the salary rate set forth in Salary Rates 7.3, 7.4, and 7.5 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category B, contained in Exhibit C of Ordinance No. 16867 (New Series), be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two (2) public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.
