AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-16867 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1987-88" BY AMENDING EXHIBIT B THERETO TO CREATE AND ADD A NEW CLASS ENTITLED "SENIOR POWER PLANT SUPERVISOR"; BY AMENDING EXHIBIT A-1 OF SAID ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A NEW SALARY RATE NUMBER 91.5 FOR SAID POSITION IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE, AS SET FORTH IN ATTACHMENT A HERETO; AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-268320 TO PLACE THE NEWLY CREATED CLASS IN THE SUPERVISORY REPRESENTATION UNIT; AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-268319 TO APPROVE AND DECLARE THE ABOVE NEWLY CREATED CLASS AS ELIGIBLE FOR PREMIUM RATE OVERTIME BY PLACING IT IN GROUP B OF SAID OVERTIME ELIGIBILITY RESOLUTION NO. R-268319.

WHEREAS, the Water Utilities Department has requested a new classification of Senior Power Plant Supervisor to serve as a second-level supervisor over the operation and maintenance functions of the City's Gas Utilization Facility at Point Loma; and

WHEREAS, as proposed, the Senior Power Plant Supervisor will plan, assign, and directly supervise the work of five Power Plant Supervisors in the operation and maintenance of the City's Gas Utilization Facility; oversee the training of subordinates; develop a formalized training program for new employees; develop preventive maintenance schedules; prioritize and assign repair and maintenance work; develop an operating and procedures manual; perform special studies; research and prepare specifications for

the purchase of materials, supplies and equipment; determine equipment needs; keep records and prepare statistical and operating reports; and coordinate activities and serve as liaison with various agencies including San Diego Gas and Electric and the Environmental Protection Agency; and

WHEREAS, currently, there is no existing classification which encompasses the duties described above or the specialized knowledges, skills and abilities required; and

WHEREAS, there is no existing classification which would provide an appropriate salary range for the duties and responsibilities of the position; and

WHEREAS, it is therefore recommended that a new classification of Senior Power Plant Supervisor be created at a salary of \$2,715 - \$3,279/month; and

WHEREAS, this recommended salary is approximately 15% above Power Plant Supervisor, the highest paid class regularly supervised and provides a differential which is consistent with the City's compensation practices for supervisory classes with similar responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that this proposed new class will be placed in the Supervisory Bargaining Unit based on the supervisory responsibilities outlined above; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that this new class be eligible for premium rate overtime under the same conditions as other classes in Group B of the Addendum to Personnel Manual Section H-4, Overtime; and

WHEREAS, at its regularly scheduled meeting of July 2, 1987, the Civil Service Commission considered fully the matter of this new position, approved all aspects of the classification as recited above, and now forwards the matter to the City Council for appropriate legislative action; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16867 (New Series), entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1987-88" be and the same is hereby amended by amending Exhibit B thereto by creating and adding a new class, entitled "SENIOR POWER PLANT SUPERVISOR" in the Equipment Maintenance Occupation Group at salary rate number 91.5.

Section 2. That Exhibit A-1 of the above-cited ordinance be amended to include a new salary rate number 91.5, ranging from \$2,715 to \$3,279 per month, at rates and steps as set forth in Attachment A hereto.

Section 3. That Resolution No. R-268320, adopted May 11, 1987 be and it is hereby amended to place the newly created class of Senior Power Plant Supervisor in the Supervisory Representation Unit.

Section 4. That Resolution No. R-268319, adopted May 11, 1987, be and it is hereby amended by approving and declaring the newly created class as eligible for premium rate overtime and placing said newly created class in Group B Overtime Eligibility.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
