AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-16867 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1987-88" BY AMENDING EXHIBIT C AS ADOPTED THEREIN BY EXEMPTING SAID POSITION OF ASSISTANT DEPUTY DIRECTOR FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE AND INCLUDING SAID POSITION IN MANAGERIAL CATEGORY B; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, during the past spring, the City Council created the classification of Assistant Deputy Director and approved in concept the placing of positions in this classification in the large line divisions throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Charter section 117(a)(17), these Assistant Deputy Director positions will have significant responsibility for formulating and administering departmental policies and programs; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that
"managerial employees having significant responsibilities for
formulating or administering departmental policies and programs"
may be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance upon
first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil
Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission has reviewed this request on September 3, 1987 and has commented favorably upon the exemption as meeting the criteria set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, it has been requested that the newly created
Assistant Deputy Director position be exempted from the
Classified Service and placed in the Unclassified Service; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual salary ordinance to effectuate the unclassified status of said classification; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16867 (New Series), entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1987-88," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Exhibit C as adopted therein, by including therein the classification of Assistant Deputy Director in Managerial Category B.

Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City
Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably
by the Civil Service Commission on September 3, 1987, the
Assistant Deputy Director position is hereby exempted from the
Classified Service and declared to be in the Unclassified Service
of The City of San Diego.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the above unclassified position created in sections 1. and 2. hereof, the salary rate set forth in Salary Rates 07.3, 07.4 and 07.5 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category B, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. 16867 (New Series), be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
