AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING THE GREATER NORTH PARK COMMUNITY PLAN AND AMENDING THE MID-CITY PLANNED DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego ("City Council") has adopted an updated community plan for the GREATER NORTH PARK COMMUNITY; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has approved the introduction of new zoning legislation in the form of an amendment to the MID-CITY PLANNED DISTRICT and has approved the introduction of comprehensive rezonings in the GREATER NORTH PARK COMMUNITY to zones of the MID-CITY COMMUNITIES PLANNED DISTRICT and other zones as reflected on Zone Map Drawing No. C-738, which will prohibit development not in conformance with the GREATER NORTH PARK COMMUNITY PLAN; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the existing zoning in the community is in conflict with the adopted GREATER NORTH PARK COMMUNITY PLAN; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that development in conflict with the GREATER NORTH PARK COMMUNITY PLAN can occur and appears imminent and that such development would compromise the implementation of said community plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has adopted the MID-CITY COMMUNITY
PLAN and has approved the introduction of an amendment to the
MID-CITY PLANNED DISTRICT to further implement the
recommendations of the MID-CITY COMMUNITY PLAN; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that development in conflict with the MID-CITY COMMUNITY PLAN and the revised zones of the planned district can occur; and

WHEREAS, such development would be detrimental to the health, safety and general welfare and good zoning practice and such development appears imminent; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Municipal Code Section 101.0205.2 provide that in the event the City Council initiates a change of zone, the City Council may adopt an ordinance providing that no development inconsistent with the provisions of the most restrictive zone under consideration shall take place pending a determination by the City Council of the proposed change of zone; such ordinance may be adopted only if the City Council finds that development inconsistent with the proposed changes of zone would be detrimental to the public health, safety, general welfare and good zoning practice and that such development appears imminent; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the area generally bounded by Interstate 805 and State Route 15 on the east, the south slopes of Mission

Valley on the north, Park Boulevard on the west, Upas Street on the south, 28th Street on the west, Juniper Street on the south, 32nd Street on the west, and the 34th Street canyon area within the GREATER NORTH PARK COMMUNITY PLAN area, all contained within the boundary designated on zone Map Drawing No. C-738, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. OCTORS, be, and the same is hereby incorporated into the MID-CITY COMMUNITIES PLANNED DISTRICT and other zones as described and defined in the San Diego Municipal Code and reflected on said document.

Section 2. That Chapter X, Article 3, Division 15 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by repealing Sections 103.1500, 103.1501, 103.1502, 103.1503, 103.1504, 103.1505, 103.1506, 103.1507, 103.1508 and 103.1509, and by adding Sections 103.1500, 103.1501, 103.1502, 103.1503, 103.1504, 103.1505, 103.1506, 103.1507, 103.1508, 103.1509 and 103.1510, as described in the MID-CITY COMMUNITIES PLANNED DISTRICT ORDINANCE, Ordinance No. 0-88-47, as amended, which was considered by the City Council on September 29, 1987.

Section 3. Projects permitted under Mid-City Development
Permits, Planned Residential Development Permits or Conditional Use
Permits approved prior to the effective date of this ordinance may
develop in accordance with the provisions of the approved permit;
provided, however, that any requested amendments to approved
permits shall be subject to the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. The provisions of this ordinance shall remain in force and effect for a period of 90 days from the enactment of this ordinance unless such period is extended by action of the City Council of The City of San Diego.

Section 5. For the reasons expressed in the preamble hereto, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage as an emergency measure necessary to protect and preserve the public health, safety and general welfare, and no building permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefore was made prior to September 3, 1987, and the property in question is not designated for residential development in Figure 6 of the GREATER NORTH PARK COMMUNITY PLAN.
