AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING AND IMPLEMENTING THE MID-CITY COMMUNITY PLAN BY INCORPORATING THE AREA GENERALLY BOUNDED BY INTERSTATE 805 AND STATE ROUTE 15 ON THE WEST, STATE ROUTE 94 ON THE SOUTH, THE CITY OF LA MESA ON THE EAST, THE SOUTH SLOPES OF MISSION VALLEY AND THE STATE UNIVERSITY AREA ON THE NORTH INTO THE MID-CITY COMMUNITIES PLANNED DISTRICT ZONES.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego ("City Council") adopted an amendment to the community plan for the MID-CITY COMMUNITY on November 17, 1987; and

WHEREAS, on November 17, 1987, the City Council approved the introduction of rezonings in the MID-CITY COMMUNITY to zones of the MID-CITY COMMUNITIES PLANNED DISTRICT and other City-wide zones as reflected on Zone Map Drawing No. C-752.1, which will prohibit development not in conformance with the MID-CITY COMMUNITY PLAN; and

WHEREAS, the existing zoning in several portions of the community is in conflict with the revised MID-CITY COMMUNITY PLAN; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that development in conflict with the MID-CITY COMMUNITY PLAN can occur and appears imminent and that such development would compromise the implementation of said community plan and would be detrimental to the health, safety and general welfare and good zoning practice; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Municipal Code Section 101.0205.2 provide that in the event the City Council initiates a change of zone, the City Council may adopt an ordinance providing that no development inconsistent with the provisions of the most restrictive zone under consideration shall take place pending a determination by the City Council of the proposed change of zone; such ordinance may be adopted only if the City Council finds that development inconsistent with the proposed change of zone would be detrimental to the public health, safety, general welfare and good zoning practice and that such development appears imminent; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

section 1. That the area generally bounded by Interstate 805 and State Route 15 on the west, State Route 94 on the south, the City of La Mesa on the east, the south slopes of Mission Valley and the State University area on the north, within the MID-CITY COMMUNITY PLAN area, all contained within the boundary designated on Zone Map Drawing No. C-752.1, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 16993, be, and the same is hereby incorporated into the MID-CITY COMMUNITIES PLANNED DISTRICT zones and other City-wide zones as described and defined in the Municipal Code and reflected on said document.

Section 2. Projects permitted under Mid-City Development
Permits, Planned Residential Development Permits or Conditional
Use Permits approved prior to the effective date of this
ordinance may develop in accordance with the provisions of the

approved permit; provided, however, that any requested amendments to approved permits shall be subject to the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall remain in force and effect for a period of 90 days from the enactment of this ordinance unless such period is extended by action of the City Council.

Section 4. For the reasons expressed in the preamble hereto, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage as an emergency measure necessary to protect and preserve the public health, safety and general welfare, and no building permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefore was made prior to October 15, 1987.
