RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 267485

ADOPTED ON JAN 13 1987

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO
REQUESTING THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT (UNITED
STATES AIR FORCE) TO DECLARE CERTAIN REAL
PROPERTY SURPLUS, IN ORDER THAT SAID PROPERTY
MAY BE TRANSFERRED TO THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, on February 11, 1986,
declared a state of emergency because of overcrowding within the
County detention system; and

WHEREAS, the County Jail System consistently has 1,450 more
inmates in custody than the State rated capacity of 2,315; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff is forced to release an average of 1,400
inmates each month because of the lack of bed space, thereby
threatening the security and quality of life of County residents
and visitors; and

WHEREAS, 6,500 additional jail beds are projected to be
needed by the year 2005; and

WHEREAS, the United States Air Force owns an underutilized
parking lot of approximately twenty acres west of, and adjacent
to, Plant 19 in San Diego, which is suitable for a critically
needed detention facility; and


WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Air Force may determine that
underutilized real property is surplus; and

WHEREAS, the United States Attorney General may transfer
surplus real property to a local unit of government, if such
property is required for detention facility use; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that The City of San Diego urges the United States Air Force to declare surplus the approximately twenty acre parking lot, which is west of and adjacent to Plant 19, in order that said property can be transferred to the County of San Diego as a site for a critically needed detention facility, pursuant to the provisions of Public Law 98-473.
