WHEREAS, the Maquiladora/Twin Plant Program offers more benefits to the United States economy than offshore manufacturing sites in remote international locations; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego desires to promote and encourage economic development along its border region; and


WHEREAS, the Maquiladora/Twin Plant Program has proven to be of economic benefit to the San Diego and Tijuana border region by providing opportunity for employment and the construction of new industrial facilities on both sides of the border; and

WHEREAS, the success of the Maquiladora/Twin Plant Program is increasingly important to our local economy; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of said City, hereby declares its support for the Maquiladora/Twin Plant Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego opposes
elimination of existing laws and regulations which provide the
legal foundation for the Maquiladora/Twin Plant Program.
