RESOLUTION NUMBER R-267997

ADOPTED ON MARCH 30, 1987

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. O-16695 requires the City Manager to cause an immediate cessation of building permits when a spill has caused environmental damage; and


WHEREAS, such a spill occurred on March 5, 1987 and the City Manager ordered an immediate cessation of building permits pursuant to said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may approve or reject the City Manager's action at any subsequent meeting; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that after conducting a hearing on the reasons and effects of the spill on March 5, 1987 and having previously taken steps to limit sewer connections in the Pump Station 64 service area by means of Agreements not to connect any such sewer hookups until after completion of construction to expand the Pump Station 64 capacity, that the City Manager is hereby directed to lift the ban on the issuance of building permits but to retain the ban on connections pending completion of Pump Station 64 revisions.
