## RESOLUTION NUMBER R-268282 ADOPTED ON MAY 5, 1987

WHEREAS, SUNROAD ENTERPRISES, and related entities, by F. O. Tronboll, appealed the decision of the Planning Commission in approving Conditional Use Permit No. CUP-83-0393, an amendment to CUP-5073, submitted by H. G. FENTON MATERIAL CO., a California corporation, Owner/Permittee, for a reduction in the permit boundaries approved in CUP-5073 from 336 to 321.4 acres for the construction and operation of sand, gravel and rock pits and plants, plants for manufacture of pre-cast concrete products and concrete products and operation of concrete mixing and batching plants, together with the usual and necessary buildings, equipment, parking and storage facilities and stockpiling and loading facilities, on portions of Pueblo Lots 1108, 1109, 1173, 1183, Lot 3, a partition of portions of Pueblo Lots 1173 and 1174 and all of Pueblo Lot 1184, located north of Interstate 8, east of Highway 163, bisected by Texas Street, in the Mission Valley Community Plan area, in the R-1A and R-1 Zones; and

WHEREAS, the matter was set for public hearing on April 7, 1987 and continued to May 5, 1987, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council adopts the following findings with respect to Conditional Use Permit No. CUP-83-0393:

- 1. The removal of a portion of the project area as approved in CUP-5073 will not adversely affect the neighborhood, General Plan or the Community Plan, and will not be detrimental to the health, safety and general welfare of persons residing or working in the area in that the requested amendment lessens the intensity of the special use for which the permit is required by removing 14.6 acres from its coverage.
- 2. The proposed use complies with all relevant regulations in the Municipal Code in that the use is currently conducted under CUP-5073 pursuant to the provisions of Section 101.0510, and all conditions of such approval have been and continue to be observed by Owner/Permittee.
- 3. Removal of a portion of the project area requested from coverage under CUP-5073 is justified because the land has reached the limits of feasible economic extraction and may be reclaimed under the California Surface Mining Act of 1975 and CUP-5073 can no longer be utilized insofar as this area is concerned.

The above findings are supported by the minutes, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appeal of SUNROAD ENTERPRISES, and related entities, is denied; the decision of the Planning Commission is sustained, and Conditional Use Permit No. CUP-83-0393 is hereby granted to H. G. FENTON MATERIAL CO., under the terms and conditions set forth in the permit attached hereto and made a part hereof.

This Conditional Use Permit, an amendment to CUP-5073, is granted by the City Council of The City of San Diego to H. G. FENTON MATERIAL CO., a California corporation, Owner/Permittee, under the conditions contained in San Diego Municipal Code Section 101.0506.

- 1. Permission is granted to Owner/Permittee for a reduction in the permit boundaries approved in CUP-5073 from 336 to 321.4 acres for the continued operation of sand, gravel and rock pits and plants, plants for manufacture of pre-cast concrete products and concrete products and operation of concrete mixing and batching plants, together with the usual and necessary buildings, equipment, parking and storage facilities and stockpiling and loading facilities, on portions of Lots 3 and 4 of Licensed Survey Map No. 170, a partition of portions of Pueblo Lots 1173 and 1174 (Tax Assessor's Parcel Nos. 438-011-12 and 13), located north of Interstate 8, east of Highway 395, bisected by Texas Street, in the Mission Valley Community Plan area, in the R-1A and R-1 Zones.
- 2. With exception of the acreage reduction set forth in Condition 1 above, the conditions in CUP-5073 are incorporated herein and by this reference made a part hereof, and said conditions shall remain in full force and effect.
