RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, MAKING AWARD FOR SALE OF BONDS AND PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A REDEMPTION FUND.

(Assessment District No. 4007 - First San Diego River Improvement Project (FSDRIP)

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Diego,
California, has heretofore instituted and conducted proceedings
under the terms and provisions of the "Municipal Improvement Act
of 1913," being Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of
the State of California, for the construction of certain public
works of improvement, together with appurtenances and appurtenant
work, in a special assessment district known and designated as
ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 4007 - FIRST SAN DIEGO RIVER IMPROVEMENT
PROJECT (FSDRIP) (hereinafter referred to as the "Assessment
District"); and

WHEREAS, this City Council, in its Resolution of Intention therein determined and declared that bonds should issue under the provisions of the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," being Division 10 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, there has now been received, in proper form, a bid (hereinafter the "proposal") for the purchase of said bonds to issue under said proceedings, which is considered to best serve

the interests of owners of land included within the Assessment District and should be accepted by this City; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the above recitals are all true and correct.

SECTION 2. That the proposal for the purchase of bonds received from Stone and Youngberg, Inc. for the purchase of improvement bonds representing unpaid assessments in said Assessment District is hereby accepted and approved.

SECTION 3. That said sale shall subject to all the terms and conditions as set forth in the accepted proposal, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.


D2256 and the Resolution of Issuance to be subsequently adopted by the City Council.

SECTION 4. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the proposal and a copy of said proposal shall be kept on file with the transcript of these proceedings.

SECTION 5. That the Treasurer be, and hereby is, directed to have the bonds printed immediately upon the expiration of the cash collection period and said Treasurer shall then have said bonds signed and delivered to said bidder upon receipt of the amount of monies due pursuant to said proposal and upon the performance of all the conditions as set forth in the proposal.

SECTION 6. That the interest rate or rates on said bonds be, and the same hereby is fixed at the rate or rates as set forth in said accepted proposal.

SECTION 7. That the Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to keep a REDEMPTION FUND designated by the name of the proceedings, into which he shall place all sums received for the collection of the assessments and the interest thereon, together with all penalties, if applicable, thereon and from which he shall disburse such funds to the registered owner. Under no circumstances shall the said bonds or interest thereon be paid out of any other fund except as provided by law.

SECTION 8. That the Treasurer shall transfer monies as necessary from the SPECIAL RESERVE FUND in the manner and form as authorized by law.
