A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON NOVEMBER 3, 1987, WITH THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE.

WHEREAS, at the meeting of the City Council held on July 28, 1987, the Council indicated its intention to submit to the qualified voters of The City of San Diego one proposition amending the Charter of The City of San Diego by adding Charter section 55.1, one proposition relating to changing the appropriations limit for the Fiscal Years 1988 through 1991, one proposition relating to an initiative measure to repeal San Diego City Council Resolution R-265534 and to irrevocably rename the affected street as Market Street, one proposition relating to an initiative measure adopting an ordinance to restrict the use of Mission Beach Park, one proposition relating to amending The City of San Diego Progress Guide and General Plan to add solid waste incineration standards to the energy conservation element guidelines and standards, one proposition relating to amending The City of San Diego Progress Guide and General Plan to redesignate certain parcels of land from "future urbanizing" to "planned urbanizing", and consolidating said Special Municipal Election with the General Municipal Election to be held in said City on November 3, 1987; and


WHEREAS, it is desirable that this Special Municipal Election be consolidated with the General Municipal Election to be held on the same date and that within The City of San Diego the election precincts, polling places, voting booths and election officials for the two elections be the same, and that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego be authorized to canvass the returns of the Special Municipal Election and that this Special Municipal Election and the General Municipal Election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, this Council within the time required by law has adopted an ordinance calling for a Special Municipal Election and consolidating it with the General Municipal Election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate the Special Municipal Election to be held in The City of San Diego on November 3, 1987 with the General Municipal Election to be held on the same date, for the purpose of submitting the above-referenced propositions.
- 2. That the exact form of the propositions to be voted upon at this Special Municipal Election and as they are to appear on the ballot is as follows:

The propositions shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of each measure as provided in Section 10219 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

3. That the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of this Special Municipal Election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.

- 4. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the General Municipal Election appropriate instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of a consolidated election.
- 5. That the City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.
- 6. That the County of San Diego shall be reimbursed in full for the services performed by the Registrar of Voters for The City of San Diego in connection with the election services herein described.
- 7. That The City of San Diego agrees to indemnify and to save free and harmless the County, its officers, agents and employees from expense or liability, including reasonable attorneys' fees, as the result of an election contest initiated pursuant to the provisions of Division 13 of the Elections Code of the State of California after conduct of these elections.
