A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC STREETS, HIGHWAYS, AND SERVICE EASEMENTS VACATION LAW, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE EAST STREET NORTH OF NOGAL STREET, AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING THEREOF.

- 4. The Council hereby fixes 2:00 p.m. on the 29th day of September, 1987 in the Council Chambers on the twelfth floor of the City Administration Building, Charles C. Dail Concourse, 202 "C" Street, in said City of San Diego, as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.
- 5. That The Daily Transcript, a daily newspaper published and circulated, and of general circulation, in the said City of

San Diego, be, and it is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the Street Superintendent of said City shall cause to be published, in the manner and form required by law, notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention, and the Street Superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this resolution to be posted in the manner and form required by law and to cause a notice similar in substance to be published in said newspaper in the manner required by law.
