## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 269154 ADOPTED ON SEP 8 1987

WHEREAS, Section 8330, et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of streets by City Council resolution where the portion of street to be vacated is excess right-of-way of a street or highway not required for street or highway purposes; and

WHEREAS, in connection with said vacation, the City desires to reserve certain easements; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have requested the vacation of the southerly excess portion of Pennsylvania Avenue between Dove Street and Curlew Street and adjacent to Lots 1 and 2 of Block 6 of Idyllwild, Map 998, to facilitate development of their property; and

WHEREAS, the portion of street to be vacated is not needed for present or prospective public street purposes; and

WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the street to be vacated will continue to have access; and

WHEREAS, the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that the vacation be conditioned upon completion of public improvements adjacent to the affected properties; and

WHEREAS, the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the southerly excess portion of Pennsylvania Avenue between Dove Street and Curlew Street and adjacent to Lots 1 and 2 of Block 6 of Idyllwild, Map 998, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 17018-1-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-269154-, which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated.
- That The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts the right, easement, and privilege of placing, constructing, repairing, replacing, maintaining, using, and operating public utilities of any kind or nature, including, but not limited to, the specified sewer and drainage facilities and all necessary and proper fixtures and equipment for use in connection therewith, through, over, under, upon, along, and across the hereinafter-described easement, together with the right of ingress thereto and egress therefrom, together with the right to maintain the said easement free and clear of any excavation or fills, the erection or construction of any building or other structures, the planting of any tree or trees thereon, or the drilling or digging of any well or wells thereon, together with the right to otherwise protect from all hazards the operation and use of any right hereby reserved. Upon acquisition of encroachment permit from the City Engineer pursuant to the Municipal Code of the City, the owners of the underlying fee may utilize the above-described parcel of land for structures, the planting or growing of trees, or the installation of privately owned pipelines. - 3. That the easement reserved hereon are more particularly shown on Drawing No. 17018-2-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-269154. And are in, under, over, upon, along and across portions of Pennsylvania Avenue vacated by this document.
- 4. That the resolution shall not become effective unless and until the issuance of permits and bonding of same for the required public improvements has been completed, satisfactory to the City Engineer. In the event that the public improvement requirements are not completed within one year following adoption, this resolution shall become void and of no further force or effect.
- 5. That the City Engineer shall advise the City Clerk of the permit issuance and bonding for the aforementioned public improvements, and that the City Clerk shall then cause a certified copy of this resolution, with drawing, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.






